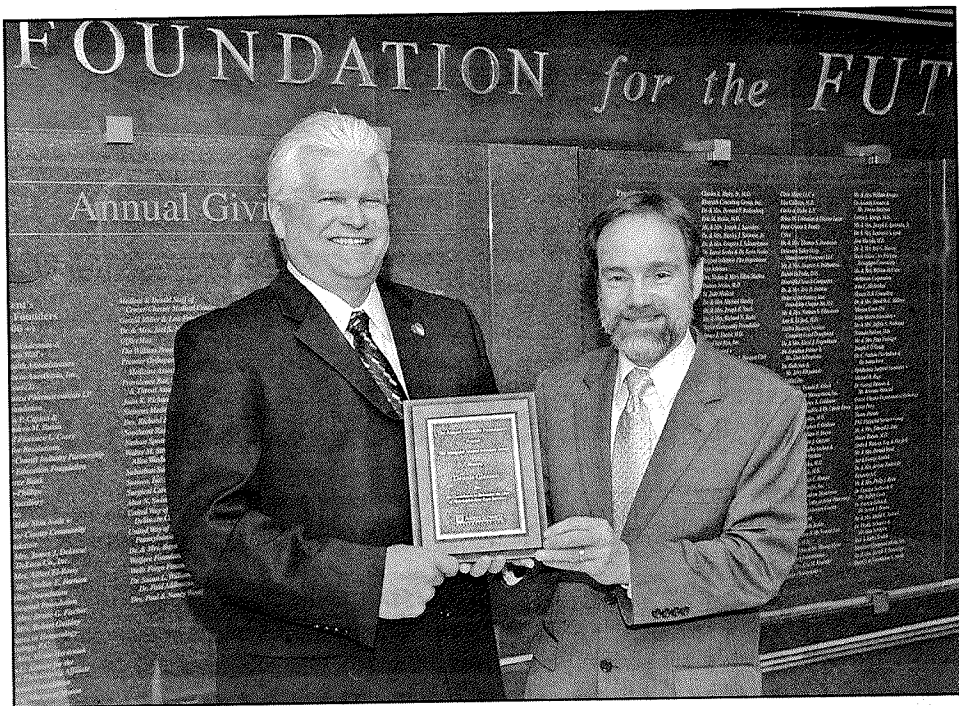

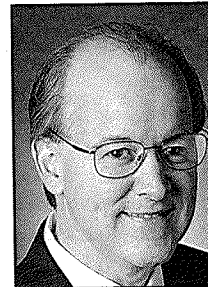
The **Philadelphia Legal Secretaries Association** will host a “Lunch and Learn” from 12:30 to 1:30 p.m. May 11.
